



Protected Health Information (PHI)

Electronic PHI (ePHI)

EHI = all ePHI in the DRS

On and after October 6, 2022

The information blocking definition includes the entire scope of the Electronic Health Information (EHI) definition (Le., ePHI that is or would be in a Designated Record Set (DRS))*

EHI = USCDI v1

Prior to October 6, 2022

The information blocking definition is limited to the EHI identified by the data elements represented in the United States Core Data for Interoperability (USCDI) v1*
